### Monitoring Wildlife Update

There are currently 22 people participating in the Road Watch Project.

A total of 77 observations have been entered using the mapping tool. Sightings include:

Big horn sheep	24
Cougar	1
Wolf	1
Grizzly bear	1
Black Bear	1
Elk	7
Mule deer	30
White-tailed deer	9
Deer	2
Unknown	1

The locations are displayed on the map below. Each point represents one event and does not indicate group size.
